

RESOLUTION 2026-02

CITY OF ALCESTER

WHEREAS, the United States of America and the State of South Dakota have authorized the making of grants from the Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) to public bodies to aid in financing the acquisition and/or construction of specific public outdoor recreation projects;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That Lisa Hodgson, is hereby authorized to execute and file an application on behalf of the City of Alcester with the National Park Service, U.S. Department of the Interior, through the State of South Dakota, Department of Game, Fish and Parks, Division of Parks, and Recreation, for an LWCF grant to aid in financing for a new picnic shelter at the City Park for the City of Alcester, South Dakota, and its Environs.
2. That Lisa Hodgson, Mayor, is hereby authorized and directed to furnish such information as the above mentioned federal and/or state agencies may reasonably request in connection with the application which is hereby authorized to be filed.
3. That the City of Alcester shall provide a minimum of 50% of the total cost of the project; and will assume all responsibility in the operation and maintenance of the project upon completion of construction, for the reasonable life expectancy of the facility.
